






Q1: Where is your primary base of operations




Q2: What percentage of your workforce is now working from home?




Q3: Have you laid off any staff?




Q4: Are you considering using the EDD Work share Program?




Q5: What percentage of staff are you considering for the EDD work share program?




Q6: Have you reduced hours or payroll for staff?




Q7: What percentage have you reduced hours or payroll?




Q8: Are you providing any extra extended sick leave to employees beyond typical PTO that have quarantined due to Covid-19




